FACT SHEET Jubilee Campus Nottingham University

REGISTRATION The Registration Desk is on the ground floor of the Exchange Building and opens at 16:00- 18:00 hours, Monday 23 April and from 09:00 hours on Tuesday 24 April. There will also be a help desk in the Business School South (BSS).

ACCOMMODATION Most delegates are staying on site in Newark Halls.

MEALS Meals are in the Atrium. There is a university café, shops and bank on the ground floor of the Exchange building for cash sales. Poster numbers and velcro dots will be on boards. Posters should be put up as soon as you arrive on Tuesday and taken down at the end of Wednesday.

Highlight sessions - See programme

'Highlights' presenters have two minutes to explain the implications of their work and answer a question. Highlight presenters may also have a poster on display **if requested in advance**. It's great fun and ideal for delegates wanting to catch a variety of presentations in a short time.

STUDENT MONDAY

CAR PARKING There is free parking if you display the car permit but its first come for the best spots around the accommodation or in the car park to the left of the Wollaton Road entrance. Avoid clamping by not parking in a restricted area. BSAS will email delegates a permit in advance of the meeting. Designated parking areas are between Southwell and Newark Halls and near Melton Hall.

WiFi internet Free access is available for delegates at the venue in most public areas of the Halls and conference venues – please ask the registration desk for the passwords – please bring your own laptop. From your room in Newark Halls you will need a network cable.

Directions to Jubilee Campus, University of Nottingham

By Road **Watch out for city average speed cameras!**

From the M1 North to Jubilee Campus

Leave the M1 motorway at junction 26 and follow the A610 signposted to Nottingham. After approximately 2.5 miles turn right at lights onto the A6514 Nottingham ring road (Western Boulevard). Continue along Western Boulevard for approximately 1.5 miles. Turn left onto the A609 Wollaton Road signposted to Nottingham City Centre, turn right into the entrance of Jubilee Campus.

From the M1 South to Jubilee

Leave the M1 motorway at junction 25 and follow the A52 signposted to Nottingham. After approximately 4.4 miles take the second exit at the roundabout (Toby Carvery) continuing along the A52 Derby Road. At the next roundabout take the first exit onto the A6514 Middleton Boulevard. Taking the right hand lane at the traffic lights, turn right onto the A609 Wollaton Road signposted to Nottingham City Centre and turn immediately right into the entrance of Jubilee Campus.

For satellite navigation the postcode for Jubilee is NG8 1BB.

By Train

The nearest train station to Jubilee Campus is Nottingham Station. Visit www.nationalrail.co.uk or phone 08457 484950 for further information. You can take a taxi to the campus from the station or a tram and bus. Change from the tram to bus at the Royal Concert Hall stop.

By Bus

By Air

East Midlands Airport is 45 mins by skylink bus to Nottingham centre. If you then show your ticket to the taxi driver to get to the Jubilee campus you get 50% off the taxi fare! Or buy a combined day ticket on the skylink bus to get unlimited tram and bus travel in Nottingham.
